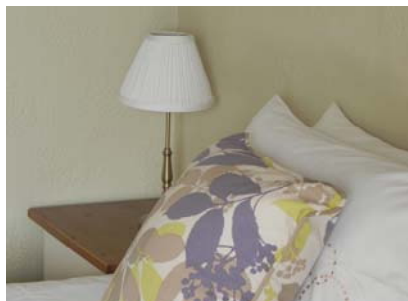




No 4 Cottage, Mounthooly, Jedburgh

Self catering in the Scottish Borders countryside



No 4 is a delightful 19th century semi-detached red sandstone cottage, situated just off the A698 between Jedburgh (2 miles) and Kelso (8 miles). The cottage is right next to the award winning Caddy Man Restaurant (30 seconds walk!), golf driving range and 5 minutes walk from the River Teviot and the famous St Cuthbert's Way, Borders Abbeys Way and Deer Street walks.



The accommodation, with exposed beams and barn doors throughout, comprises a large sitting room with multi-fuel stove and French doors to the garden, a large modern kitchen diner, utility/boot room, wc, bathroom with separate shower. On the ground floor, there is a large master bedroom that can easily accommodate either a travel cot or z-bed, and a further twin/double bedroom, and a cosy double bedroom in the attic (not suitable for very young children or the elderly). Private courtyard parking for 2 cars and additional parking in adjacent car park. Large garden to front of property, with BBQ.
